Do I need to take the German placement exam?

No- If students has AP scores of (3,4,5)

No- If student has no prior German language experience from high school or home, they would begin in GER 001.

No- If student has taken German courses at another college.

No- If the student took 1 or 2 years of German in high school. Start in GER 002.

- Yes- If student took more than 2 years of German in high school.
- Yes- If the student has an AP score of 2

Yes- If the student has an IB score that does not satisfy the foreign language
